

All-Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Air Freshener - vinegar or baking soda in an open dish ◆ Cleaner - $\frac{1}{4}$ c. baking soda + 1 quart warm water: dissolve soda in water, apply with sponge and wipe clean ◆ Disinfectant - $\frac{1}{2}$ c. Borax + 1 gallon hot water ◆ Glass Cleaner - 3 T. vinegar + 1 quart warm water ◆ Scouring Powder - 1 c. baking soda + $\frac{1}{4}$ c. vinegar: make paste, apply with mild abrasive pad, steel wool, or soft brush
Bathroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Drain Cleaner - $\frac{1}{4}$ c. baking soda + 3 T. salt + $\frac{1}{4}$ c. vinegar: pour down drain in order listed, let sit 10-15 minutes and flush with hot water ◆ Mildew Remover - equal parts vinegar and salt: scrub with soft brush ◆ Toilet Cleaner - 2 t. Borax + 1 quart warm water ◆ Tub and Tile Cleaner - $\frac{1}{4}$ c. baking soda + 1 quart warm water
Carpets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Deodorizer - baking soda: sprinkle on carpet, let set overnight and vacuum ◆ Stain Remover - club soda: apply to stain and scrub ◆ Pet Stain/Odor Eliminator - $\frac{1}{4}$ c. vinegar + $\frac{1}{4}$ c. water: mix, rub, and rinse with water
Furniture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Wood - $\frac{1}{4}$ c. mineral oil + $\frac{1}{4}$ c. lemon juice: mix and apply with cloth

RECIPES FOR NATURAL CLEANERS AND PEST REPELLENTS

Kitchen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Crease Cutter (all-purpose) - Borax on a damp cloth ◆ Garbage Disposal Deodorizer - orange or lemon peels, or baking soda: put in disposal, turn it on and rinse ◆ Linoleum Floor Cleaner - 1 c. white vinegar + 2 gallons water
Metal Cleaners and Polishes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Aluminum - 2 T. cream of tartar + vinegar (enough to make a paste): scrub and rinse ◆ Brass and Copper - Worcestershire sauce ◆ Chrome - apple cider vinegar ◆ Silver - 1 quart warm water + 1 T. baking soda + a piece of aluminum foil + 1 T. salt: make sure silver is completely covered by water and heat
Pests	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Ants - put chili powder, chili pepper seeds, dried bay leaves, or lemon peels at point of entry; put lemon juice in holes ◆ Fleas - sprinkle non-iodized salt on carpets: kills larvae but won't hurt rugs ◆ Flies - well-watered pot of basil ◆ Mice and Rats - mashed potato powder or buds + water: place instant mashed potato powder or buds in strategic places with a dish of water ◆ Mosquito Repellent - plant basil around the house ◆ Moths - cedar chips, dried lavender or equal parts dried rosemary and dried mint: place wherever clothes are stored ◆ Roaches - equal parts powdered sugar and baking soda in small containers
